According to alumni's point of view 60% of them think that there are sufficient teaching faculty and the remaining 40% said that the number of teaching faculty is insufficient.

Regarding the extent to which studying commerce has helped in shaping their career, 60% of the alumni said to have been helped fully, 30% reported to have been helped to a great extent and the remaining 10% said to have been helped to some extent only. Whereas in the Arts section, 40% said to have been benefitted fully, 30% have been helped to a great extent and the remaining 10% are reported to have been helped very little.

For helping in college development, 5% of the alumni wish to help financially, 32% showed their consent to help non financially and the remaining 63% of the alumni would like to extend both financial and non financial help.

With respect to college development, 38% of the alumni said that infrastructural development is required, 34% wished for need of development in teaching learning aspects, 39% wished for improvement of student facilities and 44% reported to seek improved placement facilities.

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
