As per alumni's feedback, 70% of them think that there are sufficient teaching faculty and the remaining 30% said that the number of teaching faculty is insufficient.

Regarding the extent to which studying commerce has helped in shaping their career, 70% of the alumni said to have been benefitted fully, 25% reported to have been helped to a great extent and the remaining 5% said to have been helped to some extent only. Whereas in the Arts section, 50 % said to have been benefitted fully, 35% been helped to a great extent and the remaining 5% are reported to have been helped very little.

For helping in college development, 11.11% of the alumni's wish to help financially, 46.15% want to give non financial help and the remaining 42.74% of the alumni's would like to extend both financial and non financial help.

In respect to college development, 23.08% of the alumni's said that infrastructural development is required, 40.17% voted for need of development in teaching learning aspects, 43.99% wished for improvement of student facilities and 52.99 % reported to seek improved placement facilities.

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
